Travelling to Catania, Piazza Armarina, Caltagirone, Taormina, Randazzo, Syracuse, Ortigia, Noto, Marzamemi, Segeste, Modica, Ragusa, Agrigento, Erice, Trapani, Marsala, Scopello, Monreale, Palermo, Cefalù

#### Day 1 Arrival in Catania

We welcome you to the majestic city of Catania. You will be personally greeted at the airport by myself then escorted by transfer to our hotel right in the heart of this bustling city. You have the day free to do your own exploring of this cosmopolitan city with its close proximity to the sea and views of Mt Etna. We meet in the lobby in the late afternoon for our first guided walking tour into this beautiful Unesco world heritage city built on the Etna lava stone. We then celebrate our first night in Sicily with an aperitif and dinner.

Overnight in Catania (D)

#### Day 2 Catania / Cooking Class - \*\*optional Tour to Mt Etna

Our morning begins with a visit to the historic "La Pescheria", Catania's' famous Arab inspired fish markets with an atmosphere that has remained virtually unchanged for hundreds of years. We enjoy tastings as we go, sampling some of Catania's best and interesting produce. The rest of the day is free for you to further explore this university city celebrating food, culture, music and architecture. If you opt to do the tour to Mt Etna you will head out on 4 wheel drives to explore one of the highest and most active volcanoes in Europe. Your guide will take you on a true adventure exploring the lava from the most recent eruption as well as historical sites, craters and exploring the flora and fauna on this mineral rich mountain. A light lunch is included in the tour, so just pack your walking shoes and water. We then meet for our afternoon cooking class and dinner with passionate local foodies who celebrate slow food in Sicily. Overnight in Catania (B/D)



Today we drive to our morning stop just outside Piazza Armerina. Here we visit the Villa Romana del Casale one of the finest examples of Roman mosaics and one of the most luxurious of its kind. Villa Romana del Casale, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, is especially noteworthy for the richness and quality of the mosaics which decorate almost every room. We visit a local dairy farm part of slow food Sicily and enjoy a cheese demonstration and long lunch. We board our bus to Caltagirone one of the iconic Baroque towns in central Sicily and known as "The city of Sicilian ceramics" due to its thousand-year-old ceramic tradition. The name itself – Caltagirone – derives from an Arabic word meaning the Castle or Fortress of the vases. Here you are free to wander through the many artisan workshops, do a spot of shopping, visit the Regional Museum of Ceramics and tackle the 142-step monumental Staircase of Santa Maria del Monte, built from 1608 in the old part of the town. Relaxing into the afternoon we return to Catania for a siesta and give you the night free to enjoy this wonderful city. Overnight in Catania (B/L)

#### Day 4 Taormina / Randazzo / Etnas Music Man

Our first stop today is Taormina in the province of Messina. Set in a magnificent position above the sea. Taormina is famous for its breathtaking and most photographed views, Greek theatre and great cafes and shopping.

We take you for a guided visit to the Greek theatre with its spectacular views, then leave you to wander free, head to the beach, enjoy a bite to eat, grab a gelato, or just sit and watch the passing crowds. Before we head to Taormina we take you to the beautiful medieval village of Castelmola. Ignored by many visitors to Sicily, this quaint mountain top community offers unparalleled views of Mount Etna, Taormina, the Bay of Giardini Naxos, and the Strait of Messina. Built to protect and defend Taormina from invaders, today this quiet village makes for an interesting respite from the hustle and bustle of Taormina below.

After your day in Taormina we head to Randazzo one of the most historically important towns in Sicily and the closest town to Mt Etna's volcano crater. The town throughout history has been destroyed by war and earthquake, although surprisingly it has never been destroyed by the eruption of Mt Etna.

Randazzo offers an amazing medieval atmosphere with ancient palaces, alleys, churches and laneways built entirely in lava stone. We visit the most interesting "Casa della Musica", learning about the history of music, from prehistory to renaissance, and beyond. Ancient instruments will be brought back to life with a philosophically enlightening experience that will give you a glimpse of how music fits into the great workings of the universe, according to the geniuses of the past like Galileo Galilei. Dinner celebrates the terrain of Etna in a celebrated local restaurant. Overnight in Catania (B/D)

#### Day 5 Syracuse / Greek Ruins / Ortigia

After breakfast we make our way to Syracuse with a guided cultural visit to the Neapolis Archaeological Park which encompasses outstanding examples of Roman and Greek theatres, including one of the most celebrated theatres in Syracuse with a stunning and captivating display of history, architecture and design. We then drive to the island of Ortigia with our guide to wander the narrow cobble-stone streets, chance upon elegant Baroque piazzas and enjoy the character and charm of this beautiful living museum of a town. We enjoy the famous granita and brioche in a local restaurant in the heart of Ortigia overlooking the stunning Duomo, a spectacular backdrop to a beautiful day. We give you the rest of the day free to enjoy Ortigia and further explore the narrow cobbled streets, venture out for a swim or relax in the square. Meeting in the afternoon, we check into our country accommodation with an evening of canapes and dinner under the stars Overnight in Syracuse (B/D)

#### Day 6 Noto / Gelati / Wine & Marzamemi

We start the day a little earlier to drive to one of the most charming places in eastern Sicily. We stop at Noto for a relaxed tour admiring the baroque style of architecture and to taste some of Sicily's gelato from an iconic gelateria. The fertile Valley of Noto where lies the Eloro doc zone, one of the best suited to the cultivation of the Nero d'Avola and Moscato di Noto grapes. We head to a historical family estate for a wonderful wine tasting and lunch. Then drive to the seaside town of Marzamemi, famous for its world class tuna, anchovy, sardine and fish products that can be purchased and tasted in one of the many shops throughout the town. We give you free time to enjoy the relaxed atmosphere of this quaint town then meet for drinks by the sea. Overnight in Syracuse. (B/L)











#### Day 7 Ragusa / Baroque Modica & Cooking Class

The cities of Ragusa and Modica are the pearls of rare beauty. Here extraordinary Baroque churches were born from stone and show living evidence of periods of ancient splendour. We enjoy a light walking tour through Ragusa Ibla (the old town) stopping to admire San Giorgio, Santa Maria delle Scale and marvel at the historic blue majolica tiles that adorn the dome of the church Santa Maria dell'Idria. During our tour we visit a grandiose Palazzo dating back to the 17th century. Stopping for an iconic cannoli and coffee at a local pasticceria we give you free time to have a wander, a spot of shopping or just to sit and take in its beauty.

Our cooking class takes place in Modica, a town made famous in the 16th century by the Cabrera family, who introduced the cocoa bean from Mexico. They began the production of what is now the chocolate of Modica. We will stop at the famous Antica Dolceria Bonajuto, founded in 1800 to taste this unique chocolate with its rich cocoa flavour and traditional grainy consistency. You will also sample some of the many traditional sweets in traditional Eastern Sicilian cuisine. This includes mpanatigghi, a light pastry filled with mince-meat, chocolate and spices. In addition to cedrata, honey and citrus rind. It is cooked to a sticky consistency and then dried and eaten as a digestive after a meal. We enjoy a walking tour of Modica and then stop for our cooking class and lunch.

We return to Syracuse and the tranquillity of our accommodation. The evening is free for you to relax in the grounds, or venture into Ortigia to enjoy Ortigia by night. Overnight in Syracuse (B/L)

#### Day 8 Agrigento - Valley of the Temples / Scali de Turchi / Wine Tasting

Making our way to Western Sicily we stop in for a guided tour to the Valley of the Temples, a must when visiting Sicily. The archaeological area of Agrigento, the Valley of the Temples, is on the southern coast of Sicily and covers the vast territory of the ancient polis. Founded as a Greek colony in the 6th century BCE, Agrigento became one of the leading cities in the Mediterranean region. Its supremacy and pride are demonstrated by the remains of the magnificent Doric temples that dominate the ancient town, much of which still lies intact under today's fields and orchards. We then stop at the white cliffs of the Scala dei Turchi, a rocky wall (cliff) that rises above the sea along the coast of Realmonte. For the brave and well balanced on foot its about a 15 minute walk down and onto the cliffs. For others there will be plenty of photo opportunities as we continue our journey to Western Sicily and our stunning Baglio wine resort set in the countryside of Marsala. After checking in, we meet in the evening for wine tasting and dinner enjoying our Baglios' harvest. Overnight in Marzara Del Vallo. (B/D)









#### Day 9 Erice / Cooking Class / Trapani

Those of you who love photography, history or have a sweet tooth will be excited as we drive to the mountain town of "Erice", known to the locals as "umunti" as it is usually shrouded in a cool mist called "the veil of Venus". Here you will sample traditional handmade "dolce", where recipes have been handed down for generations, and made famous by the nuns and some of Sicily's famous chefs and artisans. Wander up to the Castello where you will be taken back in time in the 12th century Norman fortress with its spectacular, panoramic views, wander the cobblestone streets of Erice for a spot of shopping, practice your photography or to just lose yourself in the 14th Century Baroque architecture. We share lunch with a local chef in his home where he shares with us his passion for Sicilian cuisine. The afternoon is spent with a visit to the sea side city of Trapani famous for its salt, tuna and sailing. We visit the stunning old center rich in art and architecture from the 14th-20th centuries. Wandering the maze of streets you will see remarkable examples of Sicilian architecture and art in the many religious buildings and palaces. We return to our Wine resort giving you time for a siesta. We meet in the evening for an olive oil tasting and light dinner, the evening is then free to enjoy the beautiful surroundings of our resort. Overnight in Marsala (B/L/D)

#### Day 10 Segesta / Salt Pans / Marsala

Our morning starts with a tour to Segesta, a magical place and our favourite ancient Greek site in Sicily. Set between lush rolling hills with distant views to the sea and mountains. The surrounding fields, with their exact rows of silver green olive trees and vines are archetypal Italian and just add to the atmosphere of the site. The architecture of both temple and in particular the amphitheatre is breathtaking. After our tour, we head to the famous Salt Pans of Marsala for a salt tasting and lunch, then later that afternoon we drive to the historical centre of Marsala for a passegiatta, Marsala tasting and dinner in one of the local taverna. Overnight in Marsala (B/L/D)

#### Day 11 Scopello / Monreale / Palermo

On our way to Palermo, we stop into Scopello, a fascinating little village centered around a fortified baglio. Scopello's coastline is rocky, craggy and dramatic. In a small bay amongst all this natural beauty sits the tonnara, a tuna fishery dating back to the 13th century.

We then visit Monreale, a town located on the slope of Monte Caputo, overlooking the very fertile valley called "La Conca d'oro" (the Golden Shell), famed for its orange, olive, and almond trees. We visit the stunning Norman-Byzantine cathedral, one of the most exquisitely gold mosaiced churches in Italy. After our tour we stop for lunch and give you some free time to re visit the church or take a small walk before we check into our accommodation in Palermo right in the heart of the city. We meet in the evening to walk to dinner in one of the oldest wine bars in Sicily. Over night in Palermo (B/L/D)

#### Day 12 - Palermo

Today we discover Palermo city taking you on a walking guided tour where we visit some of the most notable churches, monuments and sites which are iconic to this capital city. We enjoy a street food lunch sampling some of the popular and historical dishes of Palermo. After lunch the rest of the day is free for you to further explore this wonderful city. Overnight in Palermo (B/l)

#### Day 13 - Cefalu and I Pupi

After finishing breakfast, we visit Cefalù on a walking guided tour. Noted as one of Sicily's most beautiful seaside towns, famous for its beaches and a top holiday hotspot. Here we explore the history of the town, visit the Duomo, and the interesting ancient laundry. We give you free time to wander the cobbled streets, do some shopping, grab some lunch or take a stroll along the beach. Our afternoon and evening entertainment showcases the history and importance of the Sicilian aristocrats with a performance by the significant Sicilian Pupi. To celebrate an incredible tour, our final dinner in one of Palermo's local restaurants. Overnight in Palermo (B/D)
